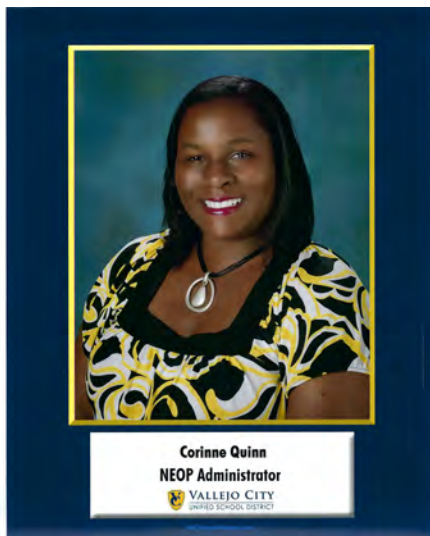
# PWP February Gathering:
